



## Ivy Tech Community College-Lafayette Region 4 2017 Chancellor's Opportunity Scholarship

### General Information

The Ivy Tech Community College-Lafayette Chancellor's Opportunity Scholarship is a scholarship designed to recognize a student's personal and scholastic achievements. The scholarship amount of \$1000 will be applied towards tuition costs and fees. Scholarship recipients will be credited with \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester. This scholarship is only valid for the 2017-2018 school year.

### Application Information

**Applications are now being accepted for the 2017 Chancellor's Opportunity Scholarship.** Please work with your high school counselor or appropriate educator (home schooled students) to complete all the application steps. Students are required to submit a completed and signed application form, high school transcript, and the two recommendation forms provided in this application in order to be eligible. **PLEASE SUBMIT ALL ITEMS IN ONE COMPLETE PACKET. (Incomplete packets are not accepted)**

### Eligibility

All high school seniors that meet the following criteria are eligible to apply: (1) Be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident or qualified alien, (2) must have at least a 2.0/4.0 high school GPA (3) must have applied and be admitted to Ivy Tech Community College-*Lafayette* (including instructional sites in *Crawfordsville, Frankfort, Monticello, and Morocco*) for the fall 2017 term (4) must plan to enroll full-time (at least 12 credit hours) for the fall and spring semesters of 2017-2018, and (5) must presently attend one of the high schools below or be a home schooled senior in Lafayette Region 4:

*Attica HS, Benton Central HS, Carroll HS, Central Catholic HS, Clinton Central HS, Clinton Prairie HS, Covington HS, Crawfordsville HS, Delphi HS, Faith Christian School, Fountain Central HS, Frankfort HS, Frontier HS, Harrison HS, Jefferson HS, McCutcheon HS, North Montgomery HS, North Newton HS, North White HS, Oakland HS, Rensselaer Central HS, Rossville HS, Seeger Memorial HS, South Newton HS, Southmont HS, Tri-County HS, Twin Lakes HS, West Central HS and West Lafayette HS.*

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## General Financial Aid Information

You must complete your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov) to receive a federal grant or student loan. While students may apply for federal financial aid throughout the year, Ivy Tech has established the following financial aid processing priority dates for each enrollment period:

- July 15 (Fall Semester)
- December 1 (Spring Semester)
- May 1 (Summer Term)

In order to ensure priority processing and "on-time" delivery of eligible financial aid, students must apply and return all requested forms/verification paperwork to their Ivy Tech Financial Aid Office by the priority processing dates above. Meeting this priority date gives Ivy Tech the necessary time to review and process your aid request accurately and on time, as determined by eligibility. It is recommended that you begin the financial aid application process at least 6-8 weeks before the priority processing date stated here; however, March 1<sup>st</sup> of every year is the FASFA priority application deadline.
