Winners will be announced at the school awards ceremony at the winner's school. Each winner will receive a letter of instruction on how to obtain their scholarship award.

Completed applications must be returned to the high school counselor by April 24, 2017 for the applicant to be eligible for this year's scholarship awards. It is preferred that applications are typed but hand written applications will be accepted.
